Here is a home safety checklist

- Install and maintain smoke alarms and fire extinguishers
- Make and practice a family fire escape plan with a meeting place outside
- Post emergency numbers near a phone
- Unplug small appliances when not in use
- Clear all exits of obstructions
- Change furnace filters frequently
- Clean the lint screen on the clothes dryer before each use
- Clean fireplace, and wood stove chimneys before each heating season
- Hide matches and lighters out of children's sight and reach
- Do not overload outlets
- Turn off space heaters and blow out candles before leaving home or going to bed
