They stop right here in Garfield with amazing flavored fruit.



Their mission is to bring good, fresh fruit at a reasonable price directly from the orchard to your family. By removing the middle man, they are able to achieve this goal. They do not have storage facilities or distribution centers where your fruit will grow old waiting for a home in a grocery store bin. Their fruit is literally picked from the orchard, loaded onto their trucks, and brought to the delivery sites where you pick up your order. It's that simple!
