- ◆ Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.

- ◆ November 1 to April 1 there is **NO PARKING of any vehicles or other items** on the streets from 2a.m. to 7a.m. for snow removal.

Tickets will be issued to offenders.



- ◆ There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City Of Garfield is in the process of developing a wellhead protection management plan for its drinking water supply wells as required in the Minnesota Wellhead Protection Rule (part 4720.5350, subparts 1-2). A copy of the plan is available for review at city hall or by contacting Paulynn Terhark by phone at (320)834-2238.

This portion of the plan includes information pertaining to:

1. The inventory of potential contaminants of concern within the drinking water supply management area;
2. The data that was considered in this portion of the plan;
3. Issues, problems, and concerns within the drinking water supply management area;
4. Goals, objectives, and action strategies to address the issues and concerns within the drinking water supply management area;
5. A plan evaluation strategy; and
6. A contingency strategy in the event of water system disruption.

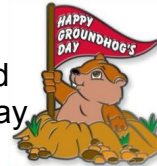
