ORDINANCE NO. 129 CITY OF GARFIELD

AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to "opt out" of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARFIELD ORDAINS as follows:

Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Garfield opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

Effective Date: This Ordinance, adopted by the City Council on August 22, 2016, becomes effective the day following publication of the ordinance, or summary therefore, in the City's legal newspaper.
