

NOTICE UTILITY RATE INCREASE

At the February 12, 2018 City Council meeting, Council passed an increase to the monthly water, sewer, and storm water rates. The monthly base rate will increase to \$70.87. This change will take effect with the April 25th billing.

Just a reminder...

Water meter reading is done on a quarterly bases.

The next scheduled reading will be effective March 25th. Please read your meter and return the meter reading card to City Hall.


Don't forget that you can pay your monthly water/sewer billing with out having to leave your home

Important Information Regarding Property Assessments

This may affect your 2019 property taxes.

The Open Book Meeting for the City of Garfield in Douglas County, Minnesota, will meet on Friday, April 13, at 9:00 AM at the Courthouse - Board Room by appointment only, for the assessment year 2018 (taxes payable 2019). The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether property in the jurisdiction has been properly valued and classified by the assessor.

If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your Assessor's office at (320) 762-3884 to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation or classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear at the Open Book Meeting to appeal. The Open Book Meeting staff will review your assessment and may make corrections as needed. You must appeal to the Open Book Meeting before appealing to the county board of appeal and equalization. All appeals are by appointment. Call the Douglas County Assessor's Office at (320) 762-3884 to schedule an appointment.
