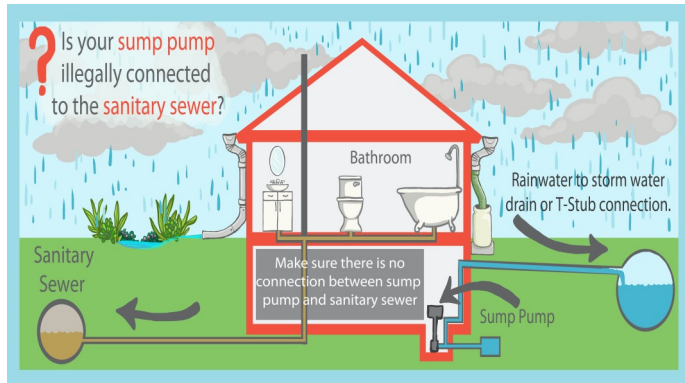


SUMP PUMP INFO

City of Garfield Sewer Ordinance
December 2014

ARTICLE VI Use of Public Services

Sec. 1 No person(s) shall discharge or cause to be discharged any unpolluted water such as stormwater, ground water, roof runoff, surface drainage, or non-contact cooling water, including water discharged from sump pumps, to any sanitary sewer.

Sec. 2 Stormwater and all other unpolluted drainage shall be discharged to such sewers as are specifically designed as storm sewers or to a natural outlet approved by the City and other regulatory agencies. Industrial cooling water or unpolluted process waters may be discharged to a storm sewer or natural outlet on approval of the City and upon approval and the issuance of a discharge permit by the MPCA.

ARTICLE X Penalties

Sec. 1 Any person found to be violating any provision of this ordinance, shall be served by the City with written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time limit for the satisfactory correction thereof. The offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.

Sec. 2 Any person who shall continue any violation beyond the time limit provided for in Section 1 of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be fined in the amount not exceeding \$200.00 for each violation. Each day in which any such violation occurs shall be deemed as a separate offense.

Sec. 3 Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall become liable to the City for any expense, loss, or damage occasioned by the City by reason of such violation.

Snowplowing Policy

Tickets will be issued to offenders for the following.



- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.
- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.

- November 1st to April 1st there is **no parking** on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.

- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.



- There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.
