Did you know that as a resident of the City of Garfield, you can rent the Community Center for \$50 a day for your event plus a damage deposit

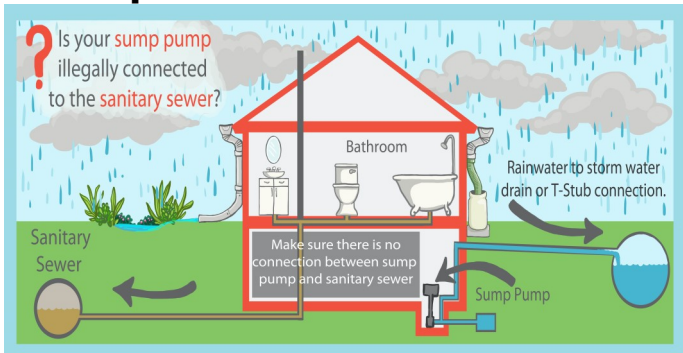
