



The City Office has been receiving several calls about dogs barking at all times of the day <u>and</u> night. This is a violation of the -

City of Garfield Nuisance Ordinance #101.



#### SECTION SIX. NOISE VIOLATIONS.

(7) A dog which habitually barks or cries such that it is audible off of the owner's or caretaker's premises. Habitual barking or crying shall be defined as barking or crying for repeated intervals of at least five minutes with less than one minute of interruption.



Please be considerate to your neighbors and do your part to control your pet.
