Before you take things out on the City Employees, City Council members are the decision-makers.

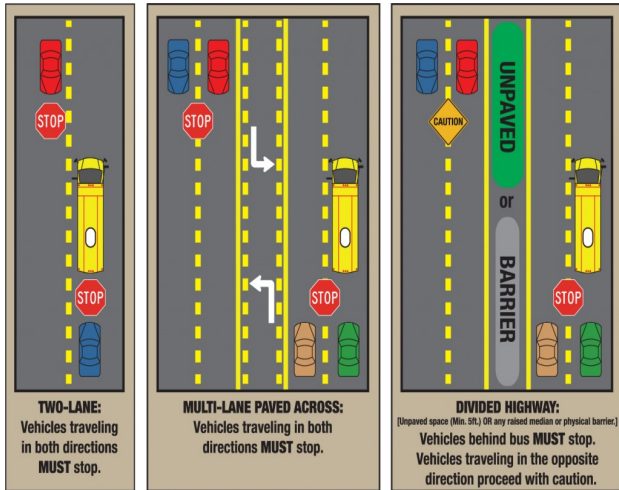

Reading your water meter quarterly may save you some \$\$\$\$\$\$. The longer you have a leak the more it will cost.



Fix leaky faucets immediately. A leaky faucet that drips at a rate of one drip per second can waste more than 3,000 gallons per year. That's a 'nice save' for Minnesota's water future.
