SUMP PUMP USEAGE

Ordinance #103
City of Garfield Sewer Ordinance

The City of Garfield's Ordinance #103 prohibits draining groundwater into the sanitary sewer system. As part of the City's goal to minimize infiltration of groundwater into the sanitary sewer system, the <u>City is considering conducting compliance inspections.</u>

Monthly reports on the City's water distribution system and sanitary sewer system show that the amount of wastewater received into the sanitary sewer system is considerably more than the water distributed to city residents by the water distribution system. If this trend continues, the capacity of the City's retention ponds for the sanitary sewer will be exceeded.

Your sump pumps are to be running outside, not into the City's sanitary sewer system.

UTILITY RATE INCREASE

At the October 15, 2019 City Council meeting, Council passed an increase to the monthly water/sewer rates. The monthly base rate will increase from \$70.87 to \$72.00.

This change will take effect with the January 25th billing.



Snowplowing Policy

Tickets will be issued to offenders for the following.



- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.
- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.
- November 1st to April 1st there is no parking on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.
- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.



 There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.
