Snowplowing Policy

<u>Tickets will be issued to offenders for</u> <u>the following.</u>



- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.
- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.
- November 1st to April 1st there is <u>no</u> <u>parking</u> on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.
- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.



 There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.
