General Election**

If you are not registered to vote, or want to verify your registration, you can do so online at www.mnvotes.org by scrolling down to the **REGISTER TO VOTE** link. There you can check to see if you are registered and update your voter registration if needed. The deadline to register prior to the General Election is October 13th.

If you do not wish to vote in person at the polling place, you have the option vote by mail through the use of an absentee ballot. Apply on line at www.mnvotes.org.

Helpful Tips to limit exposure during Covid-19

- * To cut down on amount of time spent in the polling place, verify your voter registration at www.mnvotes.org by the deadline of 21 days prior to the election.
- * Consider the OPTION to vote early by applying for an absentee ballot online or at **Douglas County Courthouse in person**
- * Plan ahead if voting in-person and allow extra wait times
- * Wear a face covering—per the Governor's Executive Order 20-81¹

Citizen complaint forms are available online at www.garfieldmn.com, under the FORMS tab or from the City Clerk.

When a citizen has a complaint about anything related to activities and responsibilities of the City, they shall file a signed complaint in writing. The complainant's name is not considered public data and will not be publicly noted.

Anonymous complaints will not be considered valid and action will not be taken.

If you witness illegal activities, please contact the Douglas County Sheriff's office either by dialing 911 or use the non-emergency number 320-762-8151.

PREMISES IDENTIFICATION

The Minnesota State Fire Code Section 505.1 requires address numbers on all building, new and existing to be visible from the street.

The Garfield Fire and Rescue and First Responders highly encourages installing house numbers so that they are visible on your home from the street to prevent delay in emergency care for all responding personnel. We also recommend, if possible, to turn on all outdoor lights at the time of a 911 call and unlock doors for easier locating and access to home during emergencies.

This is also helpful for home service work and delivery services such as UPS and Fed Ex to your home.

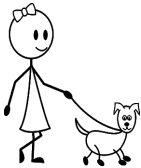
