
\*\*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*

Citizen complaint forms are available online at www.garfieldmn.com, under the FORMS tab or from the City Clerk.

When a citizen has a complaint about anything related to activities and responsibilities of the City, they shall file a signed complaint in writing. The complainant's name is not considered public data and will not be publicly noted.

Anonymous complaints will not be considered valid and action will not be taken.

If you witness illegal activities, please contact the Douglas County Sheriff's office either by dialing 911 or use the non-emergency number 320-762-8151.

#### \*\*PREMISES IDENTIFICATION\*\*

The Minnesota State Fire Code Section 505.1 requires address numbers on all building, new and existing to be visible from the street.

The Garfield Fire and Rescue and First Responders highly encourages installing house numbers so that they are visible on your home from the street to pre-

vent delay in emergency care for all responding personnel. We also recommend, if possible, to turn on all outdoor lights at the time of a 911 call and unlock doors for easier locating and access to home during emergencies.

This is also helpful for home service work and delivery services such as UPS and Fed Ex to your home.
