
### \*\*\*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*\*\*

## Snowplowing Policy



**Tickets will be issued to  
offenders for the following.**

- Side walks are the responsi-  
bility of the owner or renter  
of each property to be clear  
of snow.



- Any sidewalks that are not cleared  
within 24 hours of a snowfall, the  
property owners will be assessed a  
fee of \$100 per a time for snow re-  
moval service. Property owners are  
to keep their sidewalks clear of gar-  
bage cans and any other obstruc-  
tions.

- November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> there is **no  
parking** on the streets from 2 a.m. to  
7 a.m. for snow removal.



- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for  
towing of vehicles and all fees for the  
service will be the owner's responsi-  
bility.

- There will be no dumping or plowing  
of snow on City Property or street  
easements. If this takes place, the re-  
moval of such will be at the owners  
expense.

## \*\*PREMISES IDENTIFICATION\*\*



*The Minnesota State Fire Code Section 505.1 requires address numbers on all building, new and existing to be visible from the street.*

The Garfield Fire and Rescue and First Responders highly encourages installing house numbers so that they are visible on your home from the street to prevent delay in emergency care for all responding personnel. We also recommend, if possible, to turn on all outdoor lights at the time of a 911 call and unlock doors for easier locating and access to home during emergencies.

This is also helpful for home service work and delivery services such as UPS and Fed Ex to your home.
