


We are up and running with the new credit card payment option. You are now able to pay your utility bill with credit cards, debit cards, or echeck.

## Snowplowing Policy

Tickets will be issued to offenders for the following.

 Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.



- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.
- November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> there is no parking on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.
- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.
- There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.




