

Snowplowing Policy



Tickets will be issued to offenders for the following.

- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.



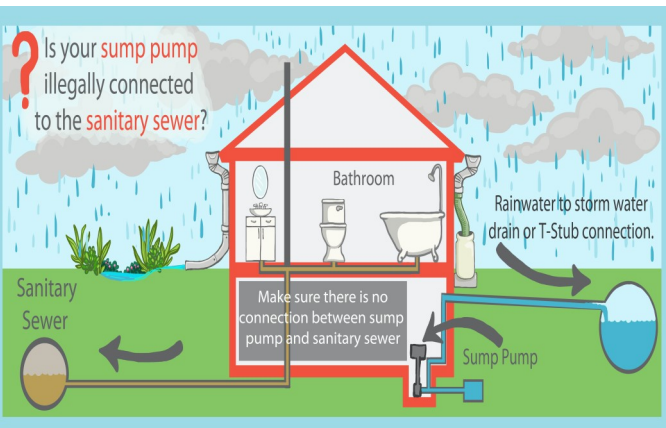
- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.

- **November 1st to April 1st there is no parking on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.**



- **Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.**

- There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.

The City of Garfield has converted to a new software billing program for the City's utilities for water and sewer. **UB-Max** will allow you to view your account balance online and make payments via credit/debit cards online. **The City will discontinue using GOVPAY.NET/ ALLPAID for credit card payments at that time.** We are planning for mid-January to be up and running for online payments options with the new program. We are also checking into being able to offer ACH payment option and will keep you informed on the process of that.

If you are interested in more info on these payment options let me know. For those that are regular users of GOVPAY.NET/ ALLPAID, if I have your email address on file, I will send you a notice of when we have switched over to the new company for credit cards. FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Building Permits: You need to get a building permit application from City Hall and have the project approved at a Council meeting **BEFORE** you start construction of a new building, shed, fence or deck! Council meets once a month, plan ahead.

Gopher State One Call: Just a reminder to call 811 **BEFORE** you dig!! Stump removal is in this category as well. You can also call 1-800-252-1166. You don't want to pay to repair something you hit while digging! It's the law! Reminder your contractors also, they know it's the law.

Sump Pumps: You **MUST** drain your sump pumps outside **NOT** down the sanitary sewer.

When a citizen has a complaint about anything related to activities and responsibilities of the City, they shall file a signed complaint in writing. The complainant's name is not considered public data and will not be publicly noted.

Anonymous complaints will not be considered valid and action will not be taken.

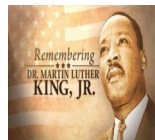
