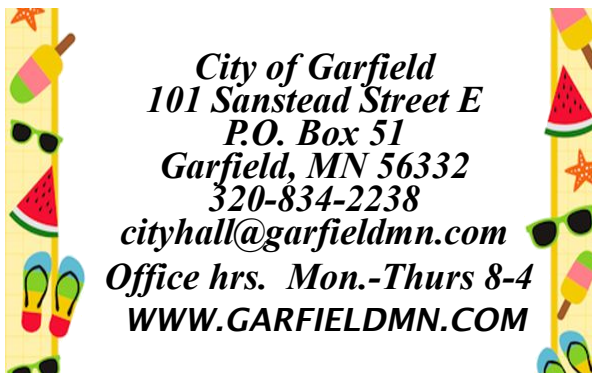

Grass clippings clog storm sewers, and create hazardous driving conditions for Motorcycles. Take pride in clean streets and yards.

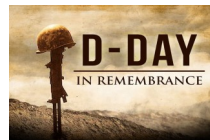

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Building Permits: Pick-up your building permit application from City Hall and have the project approved at a Council meeting **BEFORE** you start construction of a new building, shed, fence or deck! Council meets once a month, plan ahead.

Otherwise you could be charged with "After-the-Fact" charges (in addition to normal application fee) \$500 or 2x the application fee (whichever is greater)

Gopher State One Call: Just a reminder to call 811 **BEFORE** you dig!! Stump removal is in this category as well. You can also call 1-800-252-1166. You don't want to pay to repair something you hit while digging! It's the law! **Reminder your contractors also, they know it's the law.**

Sump Pumps: You **MUST** drain your sump pumps outside **NOT** down the sanitary sewer.

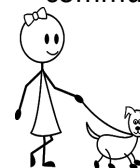
