FOR YOUR INFORMATION

CAMPERS

- 1. All recreational vehicles must be designed to operate on state roads without a special permit and must have a current license.
- 2. No camping unit may be permanently placed or skirted.
- 3. All camping units must be able to be moved readily.
- 4. Camping units must meet dwelling setback requirements and shall not be allowed to park on City streets for periods greater than 24 hours.

Illegal Use of Right of Way

City of Garfield asks you to help them prevent the mis-use of the City roads as a dumping ground.

Specifically, the only things that can legally be put into the right-of-way are mail boxes, traffic signs, and driveways. Everything else is prohibited by law, including placement in the right-of-way of:

leaves and rakings bushes and hedges branches and brush construction debris miscellaneous debris trees (any size) vard debris

shrubbery

fences or walls

plantings

structures (stone, wood, concrete or other)

garbage and waste

oil and petroleum

terraces and flower beds lawn-watering systems

lake weeds yard clippings

or **ANYTHING ELSE**
