FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- ◆ <u>Building Permits:</u> Pick-up your building permit application from City Hall and have the project approved at a Council meeting **BEFORE** you start construction of a new building, shed, fence or deck! Council meets once a month, plan ahead.
- **Otherwise you could be charged with "After-the-Fact" charges (in addition to normal application fee) \$500 or 2x the application fee (whichever is greater)
- ◆ Gopher State One Call: Just a reminder to call 811 BEFORE you dig!! Stump removal is in this category as well. You can also call 1-800-252-1166. You don't want to pay to repair something you hit while digging! It's the law! Reminder your contractors also, they know it's the law.
- Sump Pumps: You MUST drain your sump pumps outside, NOT down the sanitary sewer system.
- Water/sewer/stormwater payments are due by the 25th of each month to avoid a late fee
- All dogs are to be licensed yearly with the City of Garfield
- City Council meets the 2nd Monday of the month at 6pm
- ♦ **No** flushing of rags, wipes, paper towels, or any "non-flushable".
