Snowplowing Policy

<u>Tickets will be issued to</u> offenders for the following.

- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.
- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.
- November 1st to April 1st there is <u>no parking</u> on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.
- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.
- There will be no dumping or plowing of snow on City Property or street easements. If this takes place, the removal of such will be at the owners expense.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

The Council and staff have received calls and notes regarding a number of concerns. The most frequent has been regarding animal violations. We do have an Ordinance that prohibits running at large and not cleaning up after your pet!! There have been a number of calls regarding stray cats as well. We strongly urge you to **NOT** feed these animals. They will enter open garages, sheds etc. and their waste can spread disease not only among household pets but people as well.

There are also a number of yards that have an undue amount of trash, household appliances, automobiles and parts, and yard waste that are not being cleaned up. We are asking that property owners **PLEASE** make an effort to clean up before winter.
