UTILITY RATE INCREASE

At the December 2022 City Council meeting, Council passed an increase to the monthly water/sewer/stormwater rates. The monthly base rate will increase to \$75.00.

The excess gallon rate will increase from .003¢ to .006¢.

These changes will take effect with the March 25th billing.

This is a reminder to all property owners.

You are responsible for clearing the snow from YOUR sidewalks.

If the sidewalks are not cleared within **24** hours of a snow fall, the property owner will be assessed a \$100 fee per a time for snow removal.



Property owners are to keep their sidewalks and the road right-away clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.

Snowplowing Policy



Tickets will be issued to offenders for the following.

- Side walks are the responsibility of the owner or renter of each property to be clear of snow.



- Any sidewalks that are not cleared within 24 hours of a snowfall, the property owners will be assessed a fee of \$100 per a time for snow removal service. **Property owners are to keep their sidewalks clear of garbage cans and any other obstructions.**

- **November 1st to April 1st there is no parking on the streets from 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. for snow removal.**



- Glenn's Towing will be contacted for towing of vehicles and all fees for the service will be the owner's responsibility.
